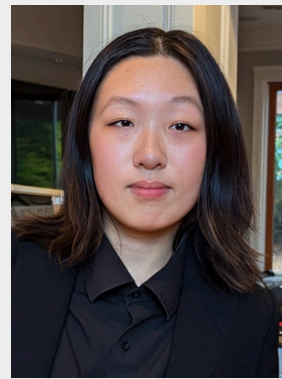
Justin Zhu

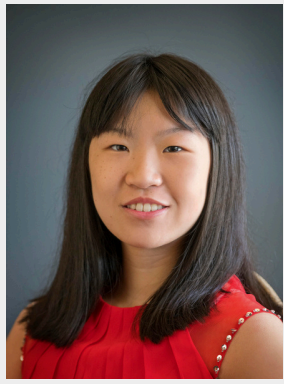
Ethan Park
